III) MIŠLJENJE I PRIJEDLOG KOMISIJE

Na osnovu detaljnog uvida u dostavljenu dokumentaciju o akademskim referencama kandidatkinje Silajdžić dr Sabine, a u kontekstu neophodnih kriterija za izbor u zvanje redovni profesor, Komisija konstatuje da je dr Sabina Silajdžić ispunila sve uslove za izbor nastavnika u zvanje redovni profesor, kako slijedi: provela je jedan izborni period u zvanju vanrednog profesora, objavila je najmanje dvije knjige i najmanje osam naučnih radova iz oblasti Međunarodna ekonomija i razvoj u priznatim publikacijama koje se nalaze u relevantnim naučnim bazama podataka te je uspješno završila mentorstvo najmanje jednom kandidatu za stepen drugog ciklusa studija. U kontekstu uslova za izbor koji se odnosi na uspješno završeno mentorstvo najmanje jednom kandidatu za stepen trećeg ciklusa studija, Komisija je izvršila ekvivalenciju navedenog uslova sa tri dodatna naučna rada objavljena u relevantnim bazama podataka u skladu sa članom 199. Statuta Univerziteta u Sarajevu. Svoj nastavni, naučno-istraživački i pedagoški rad dr Sabina Silajdžić je uspješno obavljala na sva tri ciklusa visokoškolskog obrazovanja kroz veći broj predmeta iz oblasti Međunarodna ekonomija i razvoj. Također, Komisija ističe da Kandidat ima veoma bogato iskustvo u nastavno-pedagoškom radu koje traje 20 godina.

Silajdžić dr Sabina posjeduje međunarodni akademski obrazovni profil i iskustvo. Dodiplomski studij je završila na Anglo-American College-u u Pragu, magistrirala je na Univerzitetu u Bolonji, a doktorirala je na Staffordshire University u Engleskoj. Osim navedenog međunarodnog akademskog iskustva u svom obrazovanju, kandidatkinja posjeduje značajno iskustvo u međunarodnim istraživačkim projektima. Komisija konstatuje da se specifično iskustvo Kandidatkinje odnosi na istraživanja o tranzicijskim problemima prvenstveno sa naglaskom na zemljama Centralne i Istočne Evrope i Jugoistočne Evrope, uključujući pitanja ekonomskog rasta i konvergencije, industrijskog restrukturiranja i konkurentnosti, stranih direktnih investicija, te okolinske politike. Sagledavanjem obuhvata i metodologije publikovanih naučnih istraživanja, Komisija konstatuje da Kandidatkinja posjeduje znanja iz oblasti međunarodne i primijenjene ekonomije, te posebno naglašava primjenu različitih ekonometrijskih metoda i tehnika u člancima i studijama objavljenim u referentnim časopisima i od strane referentnih institucija.
