For the enrolment of the 11th student generation of Doctoral study according to Bologna model („3+2+3“) 2019/2020 academic year

Doctoral program of School of Economics and Business in Sarajevo is developed as the result of Tempus project in cooperation with Faculty of Economics of University Vienna and Faculty of Economics of University Ljubljana and presents part of the ECTS-based curricula (3+2+3).

I

Candidates for the Doctoral program in Management/Business and Economics may apply if they have completed Second cycle of study according to the Bologna model, as well as those who completed postgraduate (master) program according to pre-Bologna model and acquired master degree in Economics / Management / Business economics with a condition that they have obtained a minimum average grade of 8 (C) and higher, or equivalent value.

II

The minimum number of students required for the study to be organized is ten candidates.

III

The list of documentation for the application:

1. Diploma paper – I cycle study/undergraduate study (certificate copy)
2. Certificate of passed exams – I cycle of study / undergraduate study (certificate copy)
3. Diploma paper – II cycle / postgraduate study (certificate copy)
4. Certificate of passed exams - II cycle of study / postgraduate study (original)
5. Birth certificate (certified copy)
6. Two recommendations (original)
7. Biography with bibliography
8. “Research statement” - explanation (200-500 words) about the field of research the candidate wants to deal with
9. Decision on nostrification of diplomas, if the candidate has obtained previous titles outside Bosnia and Herzegovina - certificate copy.

The deadline for application is 30 days from the date of publication in newspapers.

Price of study is 21.000 KM and it includes all costs of the program (teaching, exams, and thesis defense).
