

SYSTEM OF CLASSES DELIVERY IN THE 2017/18 ACADEMIC YEAR

(Adopted at the session of All-Faculty Council of 10/09/2014)

SUMMER SEMESTER

Classes for full-time non-paying and paying students shall be delivered according to a system that combines the classic – 'in-class' and 'online' form of delivery, together with the use of online materials from the standard Moodle courseware or from the DL site. Two weeks of breaks in classes delivery have been introduced: the eighth week, or the so-called 'assignment week', when midterm exams (tests, knowledge assessment) are organized, and the so-called 'study week' in the 15th week, which students can use as the preparation for final exams, which follow in the 16th week of the semester.

Schedule of activities by weeks for the summer semester is as follows:

15 weeks: 10 in-class + 3 online + 8th week – ass.week + 15th week – study week

If a course's syllabus provides for the second term exam – test scheduled for the 15th week, it will be delivered in this week. Besides, if courses include other forms of knowledge assessment (term paper, project, presentation, homework, etc.), all these activities will proceed in parallel to classes, but within the scheduled times for classes in the actual course. Tests can be written according to the classic, 'in-class' model, or via the courseware (online tests).
