USAID Developing Sustainable Tourism in Bosnia and Herzegovina (Turizam) and the **Tourism Board of Canton Sarajevo** are pleased to share with you new thematic itineraries and programs that link Sarajevo to the nearby towns, villages, and attractions that have been identified and selected as part of the **Sarajevo Hub and Spokes model**.

This innovative model aims at increasing the number of visitors, spending, and length of stay in the City of Sarajevo and its satellite municipalities/cities located in its immediate vicinity within 1.5 hour's drive. **The Sarajevo Hub and Spokes model connects Sarajevo with 12 destinations** through a package of full-day or half-day offers/itineraries, offering diverse trip and excursion options for regional and international travelers leading to the extended length of stay and increased per visitor spending thus augmenting local economic benefits, new investments, and job creation.

The criteria for selecting the 12 Spokes include **proximity to Sarajevo, infrastructural access, a plethora of cultural, historical, and natural attractions, unique experiences, accommodation facilities, the interest of the municipality/organization to partake**, and based on that, a series of focus groups with relevant stakeholders were conducted to collect data on available attractions, experiences, and natural and cultural-historical assets.

Sarajevo Hub and Spokes destinations include: **Bjelašnica/Igman, Fojnica, Ilijaš, Kakanj, Kiseljak, Konjic, Kreševo, Pale/Jahorina, Travnik, Vareš, Visoko** and **Zenica**.

On the following pages, you can find a series of suggested thematic programs that suit different profiles of visitors and different interests.

10 Must-See Attractions in Sarajevo



Baščaršija, Sarajevo's Old Town, featuring the iconic Sebilj fountain, is a cultural and historical hub with narrow, cobblestone streets lined with traditional crafts and artisan shops, restaurants, and cafes, transitioning at Ferhadija Street into a blend of Eastern and Western architectural influences.



The Latin Bridge, built in the mid-16th century over the Miljacka River, is a historic landmark in Sarajevo, famously known as the site of Archduke Franz Ferdinand's assassination, which triggered the First World War.



The Sarajevo Tunnel, a crucial lifeline during the Sarajevo siege (1992-1995), the longest military siege of a capital city in modern history (1,425 days), now serves as a museum, showcasing exhibits and allowing visitors to experience a section of the tunnel that once provided vital supplies and passage for the city's residents.

Sarajevo City Hall, or Vijećnica, a restored Austro-Hungarian architectural masterpiece, symbolizes the city's resilience and heritage, featuring intricate carvings, colorful murals, and beautiful stained glass, now standing as a testament to historical preservation.



The Trebević cable car offers a scenic nine-minute ride with panoramic views of Sarajevo, reconnecting the city to its beloved Olympic Mountain and popular recreation areas.



Sarajevo's rich **multireligious heritage** is embodied in significant landmarks like the Gazi Husrev Bey Mosque, the Cathedral of Jesus' Sacred Heart, the Cathedral of the Nativity of the Theotokos, and the Ashkenazi Synagogue, reflecting centuries of co-existence.

The Sarajevo Olympic Museum preserves the legacy of the 1984 Winter Olympics, surrounded by the Olympic Mountains of Bjelašnica, Trebević, and Igman, which continue to attract outdoor enthusiasts and feature historical Olympic infrastructure.



Sarajevo's **natural sanctuaries**, such as the Spring of the Bosna River, Skakavac Waterfall, and Bentbaša, offer serene environments, picturesque trails, and historical landmarks, perfect for nature lovers and photographers.



Sarajevo's **museums**, including the National Museum of Bosnia and Herzegovina, Galerija 11/07/95, and the War Childhood Museum, provide deep insights into the city's rich history, cultural diversity, and wartime experiences.



Sarajevo's **viewpoints**, like the Yellow Bastion, White Bastion, and Avaz Twist Tower, offer stunning panoramic views, allowing visitors to appreciate the city's beauty from various historical and modern perspectives.



And now that you've explored these highlights, don't miss the chance to discover other attractions surrounding Sarajevo.

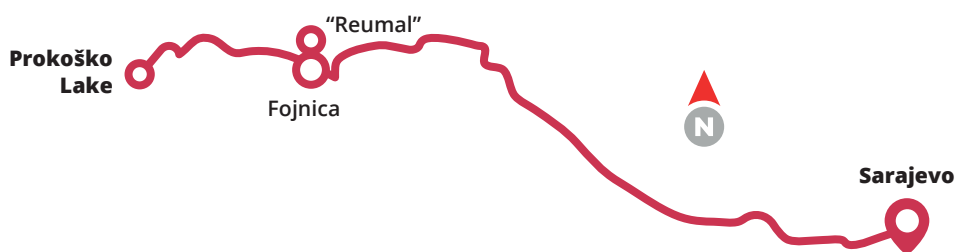

Prokoško Lake represents one of the most stunning natural features that you can find in all of Bosnia and Herzegovina. Spend an entire day exploring, mild hiking, and visiting various sites nestled at unique locations. Learn about the history of the areas while enjoying breath-taking scenery, beautiful landscapes, and authentic gastronomic specialties prepared by skilled locals. Witness the natural phenomena and develop an understanding of why Fojnica and its natural features are a true wealth of Bosnia and Herzegovina. Before heading back to the City of Sarajevo, take time to relax and refuel energy by enjoying a massage, sauna, and whirlpool at the Spa & Wellness Center Reumal. Optionally, have a traditional dinner there.



The first step is going to be a one-hour ride to Fojnica, the town known for its thermal springs, medicinal mineral waters, well-preserved Franciscan heritage, medieval tombstones, natural landscapes, and centuries-old local customs and gastronomy.

Once you arrive at Fojnica, the town that has settled near the incredible Vranica Mountain, have breakfast at a trademark local restaurant. The Restaurant Ribnjak, located near Pavlovac stream is famous for its cuisine, terrific service, and an atmosphere that will provide you with an opportunity to truly enjoy your meals and prepare for the next stop, which is the natural pearl Prokoško Lake.



On the way to the glacier "Mountain Eye" Prokoško Lake, ride through the stunning scenery of dense forests, far from the everyday noise of city life.

Through a walking tour of Prokoško Lake, explore one of the most beautiful areas in Bosnia and Herzegovina, represented by endemic species and a wonderful mountain oasis. Stroll down the nomadic village and explore unique nomadic architecture and wooden shepherds' huts. Visit the only mosque in Europe that is sitting at 1666 meters above sea level.

Meet the locals and learn about their customs and daily life. Try locally made authentic Prokoško tea, cheese and cranberries. Have lunch and enjoy fresh local food in the natural environment of Prokoško Resort, located at the site that provides the most beautiful view of Prokoško Lake and its natural surroundings, as well as the remarkable nomadic village.



After the discovery and exploration of Prokoško Lake, head back to the historical town of Fojnica for a one-hour session of body and mind rejuvenation at Spa & Wellness Center Reumal. Optionally, have dinner or visit Franciscan Museum before you go back to Sarajevo.

Sarajevo

Fojnica is a remarkable historical town that has been built on gold-bearing rivers, located about 60 kilometers from Sarajevo. It is represented by religious, cultural, and historical heritage as well as archaeological findings dating back to the ages of the Roman Empire and beyond. Today known for its natural monuments, medicinal mineral waters, and thermal springs, Fojnica is also home to some of the country's largest medieval tombstones stećci. Visit and discover the beauty, turbulent and wealthy history of Fojnica, explore and witness its monumental heritage and gems that make it one of the most unique destinations in Bosnia and Herzegovina.



Depart from Sarajevo and get ready to spend the day by learning, seeing, and discovering unique gems of Fojnica.

After a one-hour ride, you will arrive at the center of Fojnica. Take a break in the refreshing atmosphere and natural oasis of Restaurant Kamin Stara Banja. Charge your energy by enjoying local food and beverages.



Walk through the town center and learn about the medieval heritage of Fojnica. Explore some of the largest medieval tombstones in the entire country, located just beside the main square of the town. Become familiar with the hard and challenging times of Fojnica during the Second World War. Visit a Partisan Memorial Monument, learn about its meaning and why Fojnica Partisans hold a significant and specific place in Fojnica's history.

Franciscan heritage and influence in Bosnia and Herzegovina are vast and deep, and Fojnica's history is also closely tied to the arrival of Franciscans and the irreplaceable roles that they played in the region. You will visit over 650 years old Franciscan Monastery that is completely functional and well-preserved to this day. The Monastery was the seat of provincials, bishops, schools of young men, novitiate, an important representative of Catholics during the Ottoman period. Today it contains one of the wealthiest libraries, archives, museums, and art collections in the region. One of its most notable features is Ahdnama from the year 1463., a specific testimony of the interreligious and intercultural history of Fojnica.



Your next step is an exploration of "Mahala Atik", an area where the national monuments and Fojnica's trademark religious and residential objects are found, the Family House Salihagić and Atik Mosque. The old town of Fojnica contains one of the oldest, if not the oldest objects in all of Bosnia and Herzegovina. You will visit them as well as learn about the Ottoman heritage of Fojnica while discovering more valuable facts about the town's development through different ages and empires.



Next experience includes a lunch break at a trademark local restaurant of Fojnica.

After the lunch break, ride through the rural landscape and witness the wonderful scenery on your way towards a hidden gem Kozice Waterfalls. Get involved in mild hiking, stroll the area while letting your mind and body bond. While heading towards Kozice Waterfalls, enjoy the sounds of the rushing river in the background, breezes of fresh air, and lively nature that surrounds you.



After the mild hiking and recreation session at the unique premises of Kozice Waterfalls, head back to the center of Fojnica for a one-hour relaxation session at Spa & Wellness Center Reumal.

Head back to Sarajevo.

Only 60 minutes away from Sarajevo, one can discover a charming town that bathes in cultural, historical, and natural heritage. That town is called Kakanj, well-known among the citizens of Bosnia and Herzegovina because of the remains of settlements dating back to the neolithic and paleolithic ages, often visited for its natural features that make up a perfect area for skiing, hiking, cycling, and other various sports and recreational activities.

An essential touch of Kakanj's charm comes from the Franciscan heritage that is found in its surroundings where wonderful Franciscan Monastery lies, boasting with its wealthy museum, gallery, library, and church of St. John the Baptist. A prime example of medieval heritage that also relates to Kakanj is the most significant medieval fort in the entire country, the Royal Town of Bobovac. The Royal Town of Bobovac is found dominantly sitting on the steep and challenging terrain, and with its structure and size it immediately instills insights on the wealth, turbulency but also the beauty of the medieval ages in Kakanj and its surroundings. Indispensable values of Kakanj are its traditional rural areas and farms that proudly present a unique opportunity to experience local customs and traditions.



After a one-hour ride from Sarajevo, you will arrive in the central, modern area of Kakanj. While in the heart of Kakanj, taste local gastronomic specialties for breakfast.

In the Restaurant „Naša Kuća“, become familiar with specific combinations of traditional and modern cuisine.

After enjoying the atmosphere and local cuisine, it will be a perfect opportunity to gain an understanding of why and how Kakanj looked throughout the centuries. Visit the local Kakanj Museum, and witness some of the most fascinating arts, crafts and exhibitions that make you to want hear more about this special town.



Your next stop will happen after you head to the south-eastern part of Kakanj, passing through private rural areas and narrow streets, arriving at the medieval complex of the Bosnian Kingdom, Kraljeva Sutjeska. Visit over 650 years old Franciscan Monastery, explore traditional Ottoman architecture and heritage represented by House of Ivo Dusper. See Partisan Memorial Cemetery, and learn about the role that Partisans played in the history of Kakanj. You will also get a chance to visit one of the oldest mosques in Bosnia and Herzegovina, built in the 15th century.

Then continue north, through magnificent mountain valleys and local terrains. Soon you will find yourself at the doorstep of one of the most incredible medieval monuments in Bosnia and Herzegovina, The Royal Town of Bobovac. Explore the well-preserved architectural remains of the site that used to be the seat of the Bosnian Kings. Walk on the terrain of the historical area that had a role of a major stronghold during medieval times of Bosnia. While within the walls of the Royal Town of Bobovac, you will quickly become aware of the stunning view that makes you feel like you are on top of the world, holding everything in the palm of your hand.

Take a break and relax in natural, inspiring rural ambiance where authentic Bosnian cuisine is prepared.





To further refuel your energy, rest your body and mind, you will visit Malak Farm. Enjoy the variety of locally made food and refresh yourself in the magnificent natural ambiance far from any disturbances. Follow the path and take a walk within the forest, enjoy the sounds of nature and explore diverse flora and fauna alongside an educational trail on the farm. Try authentic milk and cheese, take a break and free your mind by riding a horse, or perhaps visit an Api chamber to relax and gain valuable benefits from.

After the recreation session, prepare to head back to Sarajevo.

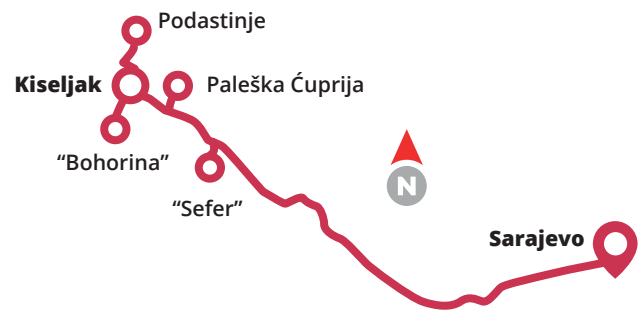

Situated at three river mouths, surrounded by steep mountains and staggering nature, a pearl worth exploring is found. Kiseljak is only 40 kilometers away from Sarajevo. It is an area filled with attractive phenomena, highly associated with unique streams of mineral and sparkling water that flow from the very heart of the town. Kiseljak is sitting on the remains of medieval settlements around which medieval tombstones are scattered. It is a historical town that managed to satisfy all the recreational and healing needs of Romans. Visiting Kiseljak means ending up in an area that over the course of centuries hosted many different cultures, with historical traits going back all the way to the neolithic age.

Besides incredible historical and cultural heritage, nowadays Kiseljak is famous for unique gastronomic specialties that are made exclusively in combination with mineral water, which is one of the reasons why Kiseljak holds a special place in the hearts and minds of citizens of Bosnia and Herzegovina. Kiseljak provides nature and culture lovers with various opportunities, and some of those include: taking a walk around centuries-old medieval settlements, tasting authentic local food, visiting the largest water and beverage factory in the region, having a coffee tasting experience within walls of authentic village, and more.



Take on a one-hour trip to Kiseljak, and arrive in the town's central area.

Once you arrive at Kiseljak, enjoy local breakfast within Restaurant Orijent, located in a relaxing natural ambiance at the bank of Kreševka River.



After breakfast, start strolling down the urban area of Kiseljak and walk alongside the riverbank of the Lepenica River. You will soon find yourself within the borders of an archeological site where medieval tombstones are located. Besides learning about the historical traits of the town, indulge in a unique mineral water tasting experience at Kiseljačić Source, a trademark of Kiseljak.



After having experienced natural mineral water springs that are well-known and highly praised in the region and beyond, taste fantastic Kiseljak Bakehouse specialties that are made by a unique combination of mineral water, yeast, and flour. Once you taste the mouth-watering specialties of Kiseljak bakehouses, you will definitely know why citizens from all corners of Bosnia and Herzegovina have heard about them.



At this point, you will be familiar with the unique history and culinary tradition of this joyful town, as well as the significance of mineral and sparkling waters that paint Kiseljak with unique flavors and values. The next step is to visit the largest water and beverage factory in the region, the Sarajevski Kiseljak Factory. While walking within the walls of the always-busy factory, you will develop a complete picture of how through centuries mineral water sources have shaped this town.



Kiseljak has a long but also turbulent history, which is why you will go on a mild hike to a nearby Podastinje Hill. Upon arriving there, you will first visit a site that relates to gruesome times that happened during the communist era in Bosnia and Herzegovina. The second location that is a must-see on Podastinje Hill is an archeological site that holds specific historical heritage, including medieval tombstones, remains of Illyrian and Roman settlements, and a late antique fort. By exploring the site and hearing various stories about its past, you will be taken on a journey through many historical ages.



Head back to the town center, refresh on the mineral source water again and take a break while enjoying traditional cuisine in Restaurant Kamin.



After lunch, head to the unique Bohorina Cider House where you will taste tasty ciders made from local gardens and orchards. Meet skilled locals and learn more about the authenticity of the products.



On your way to Sarajevo, take a short break and step foot within Ethno Village Sefer. Relax within a complex surrounded by traditional architecture. Enjoy the atmosphere that nature produces and have an authentic coffee tasting experience.



Head back to Sarajevo.

Like a beautiful ribbon, this mountainous commune extends through the dominant and incredible steep peaks of Perun, Ravna and Zvijezda Mountains. This small, yet beautiful pearl contains some of the most impressive sites and zones that one can explore in a matter of just one day. The

fascinating and memorable values of Vareš are expressed through its national monuments, medieval tombstones, archaeological sites, best-fortified medieval fortress in the country, rural households, and authentic village where one can witness over 800 years old tradition of iron forging that still functions on medieval principles. The delicious local food of Vareš is there to be enjoyed, and locals are there to be met. Discover their stunning traditions and culture, while experiencing incredible natural features that provide opportunities for various sports and recreation activities.



Take up to one-hour ride from Sarajevo and arrive in the center of Vareš. After that, have a relaxing walk and soon you will witness the only preserved church from the Ottoman period. Explore its meaning and values, hear about the stories that developed over the centuries of its existence.

Have a refreshing breakfast in Restaurant Mlin and taste local food. Enjoy your breakfast while being charged by the calming natural ambiance and fresh air, just at the coast of Stavnja River.



Head north and discover traditionally build houses and rural households, get surrounded by mountain terrain, and soon enough you will find yourself at the entrance of two mesmerizing mountain areas Zaruđe Village and Wigwam Resort. Learn about the local way of living, indulge in tasting local cheese and other organic farm products, meet the locals and learn about their customs. You can also take a carriage or horse ride to witness the staggering views of your surroundings from a different perspective.

Head towards an area tucked in breathtaking landscapes.

Next incredible site that you will explore is Pogar Village, an area where you can hike and walk between traditional rural households that are surrounded by green valleys. Visit an intriguing church and learn about agriculture and the centuries-old history of the small village.



Tucked in refreshing natural ambiance, Ibrišimović Rural Household is found. It is a perfect spot to explore and enjoy local customs and traditional cuisine.

The next stop is nothing less stunning and unique compared to the previous ones because you are going to end up within the walls of The Royal Town of Bobovac, the most important fort of medieval Bosnia. First mentioned in the 14th century, The Royal Town of Bobovac is a prime example of the extremely rich history of Vareš and the entire Bosnia and Herzegovina. This awe-inspiring medieval center of Bosnia provides visitors with a unique opportunity to experience and learn about Bosnian medieval heritage, enjoy the view of its surroundings, and feel like they are on top of the world as they tread the area where the Bosnian kings once stood.

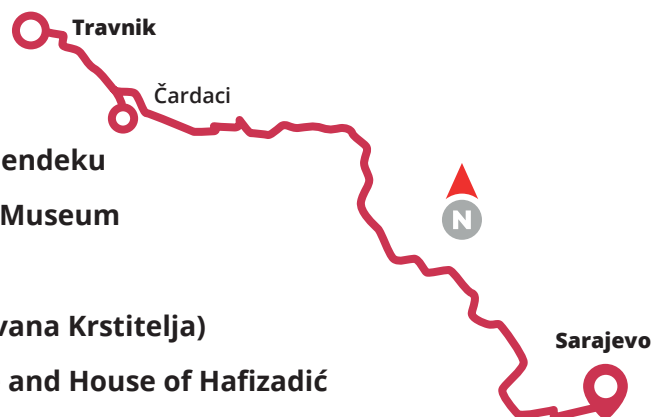

Many corners of Bosnia and Herzegovina hold centuries-old stunning secrets and unique combinations of landscapes that take the breath away from everyone that discover and experience them. However, many will agree that there is one town that stands out from the other incredible destinations in Bosnia and Herzegovina. That open-city museum is Travnik, distanced only 90 minutes from Sarajevo. Positioned in the valley of Lašva River, surrounded by beautiful Mountains Vlašić and Vilenica, Travnik is a town of many stories and long, wealthy history. Nowadays main administrative and political center in the region, this former capital of Bosnian Pashaluk contains well-preserved medieval

monuments and some of the most beautiful religious objects, archeological sites that speak unique stories of the past civilizations and cultures, authentic traditional dishes, and well-known local customs. To make this town even more unique and incredible, one should know that Travnik is the only town in the country with a functional sundial and the only town with two clocktowers that are artistically positioned within its territory. Outdoor opportunities in Travnik surrounding are not to be underestimated, since they provide some of the best terrains for hiking, skiing, herb picking, cycling, trekking, and a lot more.



The full day of discovery and exploration begins with a 90 minutes ride from Sarajevo.

Upon arrival in Travnik, taste unique Bosnian coffee at "Lutvina kahva", the coffee that even left Austrian prince Rudolf Habsburg speechless. The coffee experience is made even better by the natural ambiance of stream Plava Voda, a site to bond with nature while tasting historical coffee and traditional breakfast.

Visit one of the most beautiful and best-preserved fortifications of medieval Bosnia, walk through narrow alleys, exploring the old town of Travnik whose every corner holds a special stamp of history.



Three historical landmarks and national monuments are quite near the Old Town of Travnik. Musala Clock Tower, Jeni Mosque, and Sulejmanija Mosque, all three striking in architecture and artistic style. Sulejmanija Mosque is distinguishable for its special interior ornaments and variations of colors that aren't often seen in other mosques.

Have lunch in the immediate vicinity of the incredible environment of medieval Fortress Stara Tvrđava, in a restaurant Kastel na Hendeku. Also, consider Hari Čevabdžinica – the place that is often claimed to have the best čevapi in the country and beyond.



The next stop is within the walls of Regional Museum Travnik and Memorial Museum/Birth House of Ivo Andrić, the Nobel Prize winner. A visit to both is a must in order to witness the greatness of local tradition, culture, and customs.



A visit to Travnik is incomplete without witnessing the Roman Catholic Church of St. John the Baptist as well as Viziers' tombs Turbe where you get to create a bigger picture on historical significance, development and values of Travnik as a town of 77 Viziers, the governors of Ottoman Empire.

Witness stunning Ottoman architecture and a unique, to this day functional sundial.

Visit Orthodox Church, explore the historical pearl, and witness its beauty while hearing interesting stories..

In order to spice your experience further, take a visit to charming Ethno Village Čardaci. After you refuel energy by sightseeing authentically decorated ethno houses and enjoying the fresh air, try locally made rakija, liqueurs, beer, and various gastronomic specialties.

Ever since the first news that Visoko may be home to a pyramid complex, controversy and public awareness for the area started rising. Visit the Museum of Bosnian Pyramids, hear fascinating stories and witness exhibitions that contribute to the understanding of the past, present but also future of the Visoko and its trademark pyramids and healing tunnels.

Enjoy mouthwatering cuisine and local gastronomic specialties while relaxing in natural environment.



Once you have become familiar with the story of Bosnian pyramids and seen intriguing exhibitions and results of excavations, the next step is an exploration of the mysterious, ancient Ravne Tunnel. Besides the thrill of exploring the long, narrow network of tunnels and learning about the history of the complex, the underground labyrinth is said to have a healing effect, for both, the body and mind.



Proceed to Park Ravne, a natural oasis and perfect place to refuel energy and take a walk within the magic forest, do yoga and meditate within carefully arranged rock formations located at specific energy potent areas of the park.



Visit a local for a fur, leather and meat production experience. Learn about the living tradition of meat, fur and leather production in the Town of Visoko

Explore natural phenomena Bijambare, one of the most beautiful cave formations in Bosnia and Herzegovina. Arrive back to Umoljani Village and prepare to go back to Sarajevo. Optionally, enjoy a wonderful dinner there before heading back.



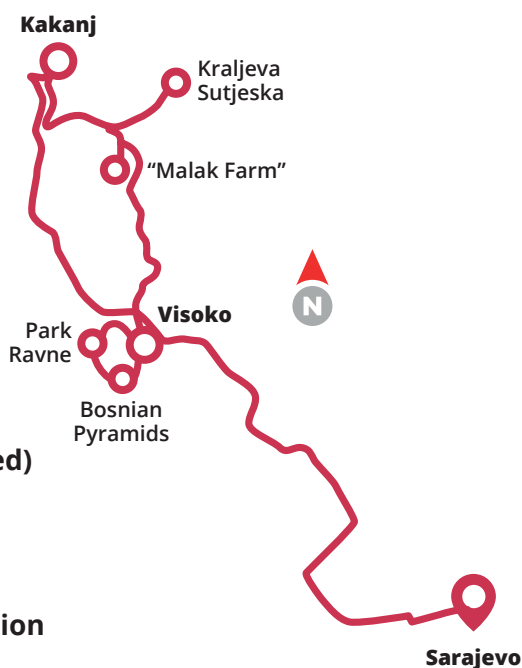

Situated in the valley of the Bosna River and just twenty kilometers away from Sarajevo, this small yet turbulent destination packs an entire box of surprises worth visiting and exploring. Ilijaš has a long and respectable history, as a crossroads of cultures and historical periods that printed various marks and awe-inspiring stamps which are visible to this day. Many necropolises of medieval tombstones are found in this municipality, some of those being praised as the most representable examples and pieces of art in all of Bosnia and Herzegovina. The municipality also contains one of the best-preserved medieval forts in the entire country, towering the modern center of Ilijaš, instilling an appreciation from everyone who witnesses it. Besides historical values dating from the antique and medieval age, Ilijaš is also a place where unbelievable villages and rural households are found, as well as locals who are firmly resisting the modern era and are determined to continue preserving centuries-old traditions and authentic way of living. Just 40 minutes from the center of Ilijaš, in the northeast of the municipality, one of the most popular cave complexes of Bosnia and Herzegovina are found. Mountains and awe-inspiring scenery in the surroundings are also one of many reasons to visit the underrated municipality of Ilijaš.



Head towards the traditional village, as an essential feature of Ilijaš are the villages, rural households, and locals that provide an opportunity to relive and feel the touch that brings back to life several centuries-old customs and traditions.

Take a break within the authentic architectural unit of Begovo Ethno Village, a site that cherishes rural lifestyle and authentic food, Bosnian architecture, exhibitions of traditional agricultural tools and many more. The village is tucked into natural surroundings made for recreation and bonding of soul, body, and mind. Located at 1400 meters above sea level, enjoy its beautiful landscapes, get surrounded by forests, taste locally made food, discover traditional Bosnian architecture and learn unique lessons regarding the traditional way of living.

After enjoying traditional food and beverage, take some time to stroll the Village and witness its stunning cultural, architectural and historical beauties



The next stop will be within a natural oasis of a protected area Bijambare, including one of the most impressive cave complexes in Bosnia and Herzegovina. Within the protected area that spans over 479 ha, various activities and opportunities are provided. One of them is an exploration of 420 meters long Bijambare Cave which contains diverse natural features and phenomena. Stroll down its narrow canals, learn about the fauna and historical findings of the surroundings, enjoy a relaxing walk deep in the evergreen area of Bijambare or take a 2-kilometer eco train ride for sightseeing and relaxation.

Refuel energy and enjoy lunch before the trip continue.

Take a short ride and arrive at Halilović Agro-tourist Center.





In the rural surroundings of Ilijaš, explore the center of organic production of essential oils, teas, flower waters, creams, soaps, and more. Learn about their story, skills, and masteries while enjoying in specific feats of nature in the rural environment.



Optionally, before heading back to Sarajevo, take a ride through steep and narrow valley and visit nowadays almost empty village Kopošići, which once was a medieval micro-center. The site still contains well-preserved and one of the most significant medieval tombstones in the entire Bosnia and Herzegovina. Take a walk around the necropolis and bear witness to the great tombstone that speaks history through its artistic details and still visible dominant features engraved in stone. After that, step foot in medieval times by visiting Old Town Dubrovnik. Learn about medieval Bosnia and hear intriguing stories about the past times of Ilijaš.



Head back to Sarajevo.

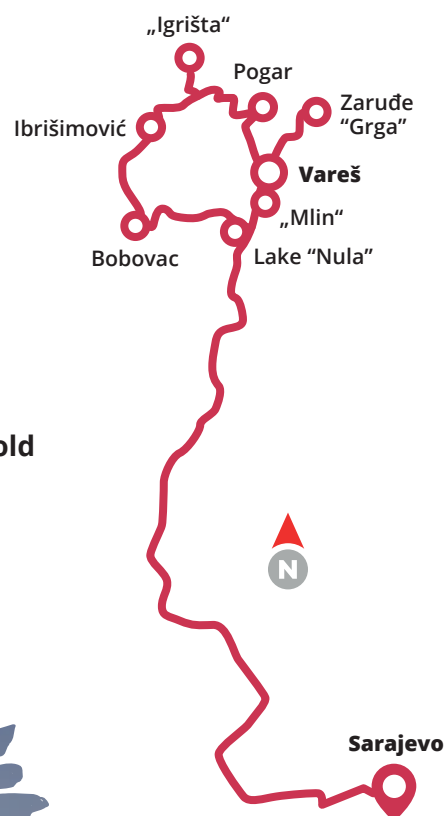

An essential part of the journey are visits to traditional villages and rural households, familiarization with local cultural and historical gems, discovery of medieval complexes and rare monuments, as well as an introduction to

local customs and intriguing stories that can't be found somewhere else. Last but not least, an irreplaceable part of the multi-day exploration of Sarajevo surroundings is the local cuisine and traditional specialties that will support the process of learning and developing a deeper understanding about intriguing culture, history and traditions of Sarajevo Spokes.

DAY 1 Sarajevo – Ilijaš – Vareš

Starting point: ● Sarajevo

Locations: ● Restaurant Diana, Protected Area Bijambare, Begovo Ethno Village, Church of St. Michael the Archangel in Vareš, Wigwam Resort and Zaruđe Village, Rural Household Šadrvan

Overnight stay: ● Rural Household Šadrvan

Start your journey from Sarajevo. Take a break in Ilijaš and have breakfast in a local restaurant. Enjoy the food and hear more about the history of the town and some of its most stunning features. Head towards one of the most beautiful cave systems in Bosnia and Herzegovina, situated within a protected area where recreation activities such as walking in evergreen forests, cycling, and eco-train rides take place. Explore the cave and all of its awe-inspiring corners filled with various beautiful decorations. Learn about the long history of the place and some staggering findings that took place there. Visit unique Begovo Ethno Village situated on a plateau that boasts with amazing natural landscapes. Explore authentic Bosnian architecture and enjoy traditional cuisine, learn how people used to live before and what their daily life activities used to look like. Discover every corner of the village and the wealthy exhibitions that are kept there. Visit a specific national monument and the country's oldest preserved church from the 19th century, the Church of St. Michael the Archangel. Ride through narrow alleys and refuel energy on nature sites Wigwam resort and Zaruđe Village, both striking due to the refreshing ambiance and interesting features they contain. Spend a night in a household tucked in nature, rural household Šadrvan. Enjoy fresh organic dinner there and learn more about the wealthy traditional food of the area.



DAY 2 Vareš – Kraljeva Sutjeska – Kakanj – Zenica – Ethno Village Čardaci

Early in the morning, wake up surrounded by nature and sit down to enjoy breakfast and traditional Bosnian coffee. Head towards the only village in Europe where medieval principles of iron forging are still being applied, Očevija Village. Explore the village and visit blacksmiths. Witness the medieval iron forging in person and learn about the long history of Očevija Village. Acquiring a unique souvenir is an option as well. Visit one of the most significant medieval complexes in the country, The Royal Town of Bobovac. Step back into medieval times and learn about the rich history of medieval Bosnia while witnessing stunning views of the surroundings. Explore over 650 years old Franciscan Monastery whose library and museum stand to be one of the wealthiest in the region. End up at Partisan Memorial Cemetery and learn about different historical periods and their significance for Sarajevo and its surroundings. Refuel energy on a local Malak farm. Enjoy various dishes and relax in nature by exploring the farm's inspiring premises. Visit a museum in Kakanj in order to gain an understanding of key historical elements of the town's development. Witness various exhibitions and learn about local culture and customs. Then, head towards a city that was first mentioned in the 15th century, Zenica. While there, explore the town's museum and further develop an understanding of the history and culture around Sarajevo. Arrive at enhancing Ethno Village Čardaci, enjoy dinner there and stroll the village. Stay in the village overnight.



DAY 3 Ethno Village Čardaci – Travnik – Fojnica

- Locations:** ● Travnik and Fojnica
- Overnight stay:** ● Spa & Wellness Center Reumal

Early in the morning head towards one of the most stunning cities in the country, Travnik. Upon arrival, enjoy an amazing breakfast at a unique location, Lutvina Kahva. Explore Medieval Fortress Travnik Castle and Travnik Old Town. Experience centuries-old architecture and learn about the importance of the Fortress. Visit some of the most unique religious monuments in the country and bear witness to the interreligious character of Travnik. Try widely popular and praised ćevapi at Hari. Visit the birth house of Nobel Prize Winner Ivo Andrić and learn more about him. Hear intriguing stories about the historical and archaeological wealth of Travnik by visiting Travnik's Regional Museum. Explore Ottoman's heritage and find out why Travnik is called the City of Viziers. Then in the late afternoon, head to the town laying on gold-bearing rivers, Fojnica. Once you are there, explore the stunning Franciscan Monastery and learn more about the wealthy Franciscan heritage in Bosnia and Herzegovina and why Franciscans' role is irreplaceable. Additionally, visit the oldest Ottoman house in Bosnia and Herzegovina, Salihagić Musafirhana. Then, enjoy spa and massage session at Spa & Wellnes Center Reumal.



DAY 4 Fojnica – Visoko – Kiseljak

Starting point: ● Spa & Wellnes Center Reumal

Locations: ● Atik Mosque and Fojnica Central Mosque, Archaeological Site Mile and National Monument Arnautovići Mosque, Visoko Heritage Museum, Restaurant Most, Ravne Tunnel, Museum of Bosnian Pyramids, Tombstones at Paleška Ćuprija, Agić Kiseljak Bakehouse, Bohorina Cider House, Church of St. Elijah and Partisan Memorial Cemetery, Hotel Bank

Overnight stay: ● Hotel Bank

After breakfast, visit the monumental religious heritage of Fojnica and then prepare for a short trip to Visoko. Upon arrival in Visoko, explore and learn about long history of the area by visiting Archaeological Site Mile. Then, visit the well-known national Monument Arnautovići Mosque. To learn specific details on the local communities and historical development of Visoko, visit the local heritage museum and then enjoy lunch and local cuisine at Restaurant Most. The next step is an exploration of the mysterious Ravne tunnel, after which the story further develops in a Museum of Bosnian Pyramids where you will hear and also see mysterious and intriguing things. Then, head towards another unique area, Kiseljak. Hear stories about mineral waters and how they relate to Kiseljak. After tasting the water from Kiseljačić source, head towards medieval tombstones at Paleška Ćuprija. Learn about the historical and artistic importance of the tombstones and find out why they hold a special place in the history of medieval Bosnia. After that, try local gastronomic specialty at a local bakehouse and find out what role mineral water plays in the process of preparation of the meal. To sit down, meet locals and have fun, visit Bohorina Cider House. Indulge in tasting local ciders and enjoy the atmosphere. After exploring Partisan Memorial Cemetery and Church of St. Elijah, stay overnight at Hotel Bank.

Overnight stay: ● Hotel City Garden

After early breakfast, check out from Hotel Bank and head towards Kreševo. Explore its stunning Franciscan Museum and learn about the wealthy heritage and unique local traditions that exist there. Visit Vrancı Village and discover some of its centuries-old features. Then, take a one-hour ride to Konjic. Walk through the historical core of the city and enjoy views from the monumental Old Bridge. Learn about unique woodcarving tradition of Konjic and also visit the Konjic Heritage Museum where exhibitions unveil the rich history of Konjic and its community. Additionally, visit one of the best-kept secrets of former Yugoslavia, a well-preserved nuclear bunker and war command center. Explore all of its preserved amenities and learn more details about Yugoslavia. Overnight stay at Hotel City Garden.



DAY 6 Konjic – Bjelašnica – Lukomir Village – Jahorina

Locations: ● Bjelašnica, Lukomir Village, Umoljani, Jahorina

Overnight stay: ● Hotel Termag

Throughout the day, several chances to enjoy rural and mountain landscapes will present themselves. Upon arrival in Lukomir Village, enjoy a recreation session and embark on exploring the authentic area of the village that's sitting at 1.459 meters. Among other, witness and experience fascinating architecture and nature, locally made food and enjoy being in the open. Also, Umoljani Village is another inspiring site with traditions and history worth discovering. In the late afternoon, head towards Olympic pearl Jahorina for an overnight stay.

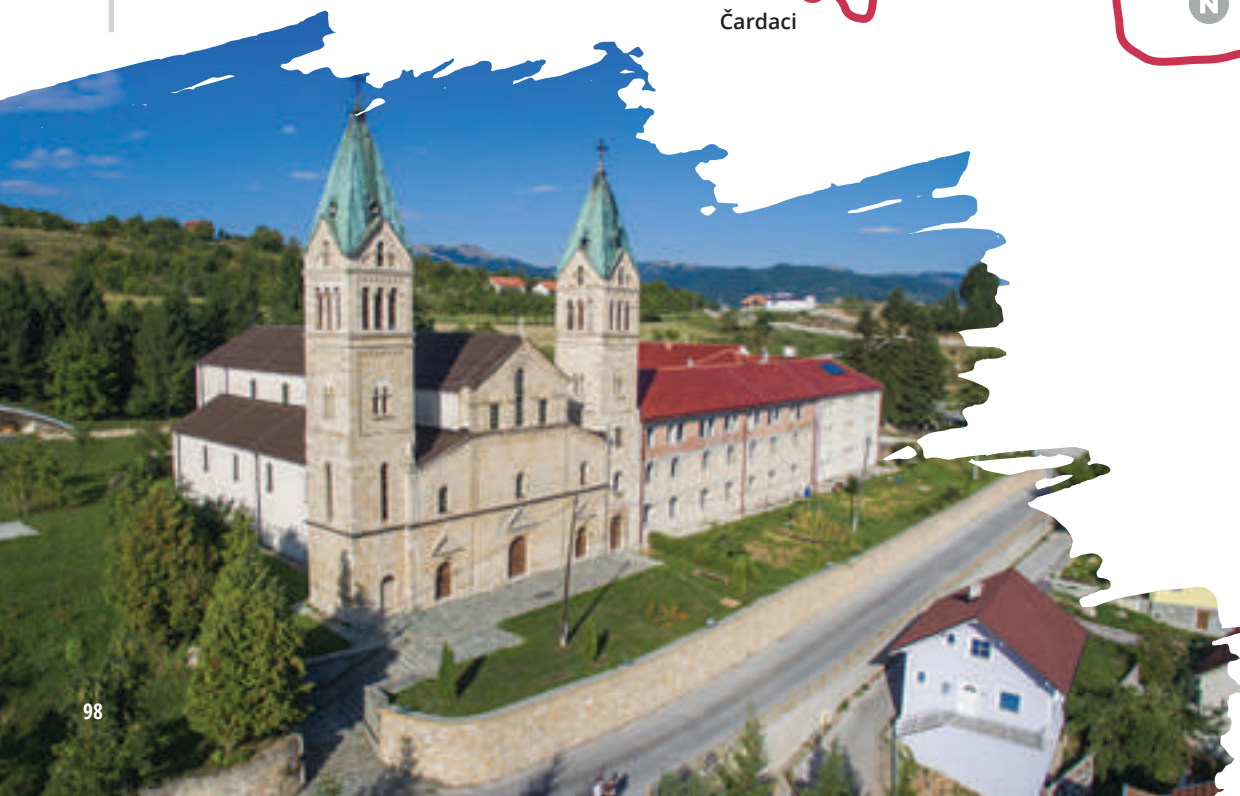

Hear local legends about the meaning of the obelisk and why it was placed in the woods. Refresh in a rural household and enjoy calming ambiance as you stay there for the night.

Learn about religious, archaeological and historical heritage in a local museum and visit key monuments in the city of Zenica.

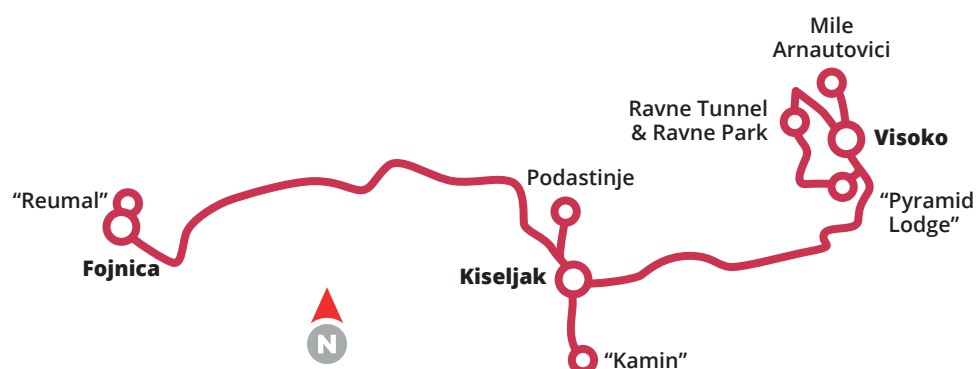
DAY 4 Visoko – Kiseljak – Fojnica

Bjelašnica & Igman

In the vicinity of Sarajevo, under a 30-minute drive away, are The Olympic Mountains Igman, Bjelašnica, and Jahorina. In 1984, XIV Olympic Winter Games were held in Sarajevo Mountains, as the first time this multi-sport event was held in a socialist state and in a Slavic-speaking country. These were also the first Olympiad held in the Balkans, after the first games in Athens. Olympism of 1984 made Sarajevo popular around the world, and its tradition is respected and upheld to this day. The Olympic Mountains surrounding Sarajevo is where this tradition lives on.

Fojnica

Town and municipality located in Central Bosnia Canton, west of the capital Sarajevo. The distance between Fojnica and the capital is 57km, and the drive from Sarajevo to the town is roughly one hour. Bus lines between them are active every few hours, Fojnica is relatively small, with an area of 306 km², and population of around 13,000. It is famous for its rich history and archeological findings, as well as for its thermal waters. The latter makes Fojnica the most famous balneological resort in BiH. The efficiency of Fojnica thermal water in the treatment of rheumatism, musculoskeletal disorders, and diseases of the peripheral neural system.

Pale/Jahorina

Jahorina is the Olympic Mountain located 30 km away from Sarajevo and 15 km from Pale. At the fourteenth Olympic Games in Sarajevo, alpine disciplines for women were held on Jahorina. Mountain belongs to the Dinaric mountain system with the highest peak Ogorjelica 1,916 m above sea level. In summer, it is covered with thick green grass, and up to 3m high snow in winter. Outstanding terrain configuration, an abundance of high-quality snow, favorable climate, 20 kilometers of trails for alpine disciplines, and gentle slopes (Rajska Valley) have made this mountain among the most beautiful and famous ski resorts. The average number of days with snow cover on Jahorina is 175, from October to the end of May. The ten-year average snow cover height in February is 106 cm.

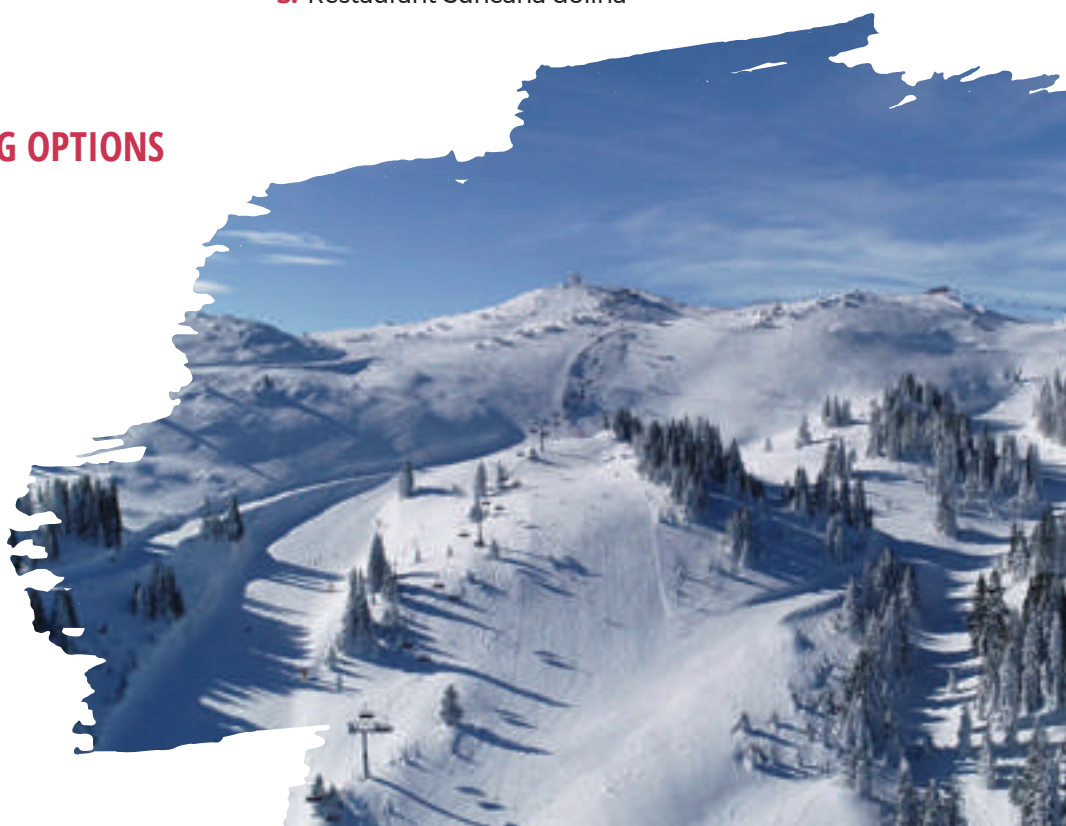
