Dr Vesna Bojicic- Dzelilovic is Associate Professorial Research Fellow at LSE IDEAS, and an associate fellow of the South East Europe Research Unit at the European Institute, London School of Economics and Political Science. She is co-director of UN Business and Human Security Initiative at LSE, a research and implementation programme which investigates private sector's contribution to peace and development in the context of Agenda 2030. She specialises in the political economy of development, with a particular interests in business, peace and development, and the role of international aid in transitioning from armed conflict. Her geographic focus and field work is South East Europe. She has published in a range of academic journal including Review of International Political Economy, Journal of International Relations and Development, Conflict, Security and Development, co-authored six academic book volumes and advised World Bank, European Union, UNDP and national governments. She holds PhD in Economics and MA in Development Economics.



Jože P. Damijanis a Full Professor at the University of Ljubljana, School of Economics and Business, and Visiting Professor at the University of Leuven, Belgium. His research interests and teaching cover macroeconomics, international economics and globalization. He is one of the most internationally cited Slovenian economists, he publishes regular columns in major Slovenian newspapers and runs the most read economics blog in Slovenia (DAMIJAN blog)

He served as Minister for Growth in the Slovenian government and Vice-President of the Council of Economic Advisors to the Prime Minister of Slovenia. He is a partner in the consultancy company Grant Thornton Advisory and has led several dozens of consultancy projects for key domestic and foreign companies, international organizations, government ministries and agencies.
