

# SEBS INTERNATIONAL OFFICE 2023/2024



## STUDENT MOBILITY

- **7 calls** for the spring semester and **5 calls** for the winter semester
- 12 incoming international students from 7 partner institutions
- 16 incoming University of Graz students via long term cooperation study visits
- 30 SEBS students visited 14 partner institutions

## STAFF MOBILITY

- 11 incoming academic staff from 9 partner institutions
- 11 incoming non-academic staff from 7 partner institutions
- 22 outgoing SEBS academic staff



## INTER-INSTITUTIONAL COOPERATION

### IGS Study visit

- School of Economics and Business has developed the programme for the 2 week study visit for master students in Finance from the partner institution IGS Groupe.
- 35 incoming students and 4 incoming academic staff
