Location of SEBS	SEBS is located in the heart of Sarajevo, in the centre of the city, one minute away from the City's Cathedral. www.efsa.unsa.ba
Why SEBS?	<p>School of Economics and Business Sarajevo (SEBS) is a public higher education institution in Bosnia and Herzegovina (BiH). It is the constituent part of the University of Sarajevo (UNSA), the largest and oldest university in the country and it was founded in 1952 as a member of UNSA. SEBS positions itself as the leading academic research institution in the field of economics and business at the national level.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • SEBS is the pioneer in quality assurance/ quality management in higher education of B&H. The SEBS's Quality Management Office is the first of its kind in the country and was founded even before the Agency for Development of Higher Education and Quality Assurance of B&H, which is the national authority in this field. • SEBS was used as an exemplary, role model institution, by the Agency for Development of Higher Education and Quality Assurance of B&H in the process of accrediting the UNSA. • SEBS is the first higher education institution in the country that initiated the creation of specialized programmes with reputable corporate partners (e.g., Microsoft, Raiffeisen bank). • SEBS was the first higher education institution in the country to set up the International Office and Public Relations Office and remained the only or one of the few to also have the Business Advisory Board, Career Centre, Faculty Development Centre, Management Information Technology Centre and Distance Learning Support Centre and other specialized offices (such as: Centre for Islamic Banking, Centre for Business Law, Centre for Forensic Accounting, Centre for Women Entrepreneurship, etc.). All these bring great additional value to SEBS's students, faculty, and other stakeholders, both internal and external. • SEBS is one of the most active members of the national academic community when it comes to providing consultancy for the real sector and implementation of projects. SEBS is proud of its large and diverse international project portfolio consisting of internationally funded and implemented inter-disciplinary projects.
Main facts	<p>School of Economics and Business (SEBS), University of Sarajevo implements main postulates of Bologna Process and defines its quality policy and quality assurance policy in accordance with the Standards and Guidelines for Quality Assurance in the European Higher Education Area.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 1952 - 2023: SEBS maintained the continuity of its operations throughout the past 70 years. Even amid the heaviest warfare from 1992-1995 in BiH, teaching did not cease, owing to the enthusiasm and dedication of both employees and students. More recently, during the beginning of COVID-19 pandemic, SEBS completely transitioned to online working environment. • 2001 and 2005: SEBS was the first in BiH to adopt a curriculum based on the European Credits Transfer System – ECTS, after which the Bologna-based "3+2+3" system was introduced in 2005. • 2011: The first programme set to be delivered in English was the undergraduate programme set Financial Management and Marketing Management (FM/MM), which later received the EFMD/EPAS accreditation. • 2012: SEBS's FM/MM programme was accredited by the EFMD/EPAS and reaccredited in 2015, 2018 and, finally in 2021 for a period of five years. • 2015: SEBS was accredited by the AACSB (The Association to Advance Collegiate Schools of Business) for the initial period of five years and in 2021 reaccredited for the additional period of five years.

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 2019: UNSA achieved full integration based on the decision passed by the Sarajevo Canton Government. Consequently, SEBS and other UNSA members lost their legal and financial independence and started operating as UNSA's organizational units. • 2021: SEBS has implemented a new and innovative curriculum at the undergraduate and graduate levels. • 2022: SEBS has celebrated 70 years of work with the Ceremonial Academy organized in the Sarajevo City Hall and numerous other jubilant events during the year (such as book promotions, scientific conferences, sport events, etc.).
International directions	SEBS has over 30 student/faculty exchange partners in Europe, South and North America, and Asia. Every year we have about 80 outgoing and 30 incoming students.
